THE ARTIST

Trinidad Albonico, born in Santiago, Chile, is a multidisciplinary artist with an impressive international career in circus, photography, and street theater. After studying photography in Argentina, she began her career in 2006 as a juggler with the music and circus band "Corazón de Manzana", touring northern Argentina.

In 2007, she started exploring Europe as part of the artistic caravan "La Mecha", traveling through more than 15 countries over five years and experimenting with street art in various forms. She later settled in Berlin, where she collaborated with the group "Familia Krapouchnikov" and co-founded the company "Duoh!Lala!", participating in prestigious festivals across Europe, Asia, and Latin America.

Specializing in foot juggling (antipodism) under the guidance of master Piraja in Brazil, Trinidad combines this discipline with other art forms, such as photography, to create innovative performances. Her work, "If the World Were Upside Down", premiered in 2019 and blends classic circus, object theater, and the creative use of newspapers, earning her recognition and enabling her to tour Europe, the Middle East, and Latin America.

Currently, she resides in southern France and is working on her next creation, "Après-coups", a performance combining physical theater and foot juggling, scheduled to premiere in 2026.




Minimum space:
